

(Unofficial results)

At the June 11, 2009 meeting of the Somerville Board of Aldermen, the Aldermen passed the following (non-binding) resolutions introduced by Alderman Sean O'Donovan:

That this Board requests that the Traffic Commission rescind 2009-18 Article V Section 5-9.4, which establishes new Parking Meter Zones in Davis and Magoun Sq. Municipal Parking Lots, in the spaces for Business Permit Parking Only, to create metered parking Monday through Friday 5-10PM and Saturday 8AM-10PM.

That this Board requests that the Traffic Commission rescind 2009-17 Article V Section 5-9.1, which extends metered parking to 8PM except in Davis and Magoun Sq. (which is separately extended to 10PM.)

That this Board requests that the Administration explain why major traffic and parking initiatives affecting Magoun Sq. were placed before the Traffic Commission without any notification to the residents, business owners and Ward Alderman.

Aldermen voted 11-0 to approve #187266 Mayor's Request:

Requesting approval of an amendment to Ordinance 1-11(b), establishing or increasing certain parking fines.

Aldermen referred to the Finance Committee a resolution by Aldermen Thomas Taylor and Rebekah Gewirtz:

That the Director of Traffic and Parking work with the Traffic Commission to move the implementation of new traffic and parking regulations from August 1 to October 1, 2009, to allow the recently formed Parking Solutions Task Force the opportunity to propose more effective alternatives to the Traffic Commission.

Aldermen voted to approve the Mayor's Request:

Requesting the appointment of Peter Miller as the Mayor's appointee to the Traffic Board

Aldermen voted to

Appoint Michael Buckley as the Board's appointee to the Traffic Board.
